Report on the Gabriel APP for use in Funeral Homes

Electronic candle systems have become a common and acknowledged substitute for wax votive candles traditionally used in Funeral Homes, Parishes, Hospitals and Shrines, eliminating the costs of labor, the threat of fire and smoke hazards culminating in an overall improved environment while still permitting individuals to show their intentions by lighting a candle. It is also a revenue profit center.


Life events and circumstances may not permit everyone an opportunity to visit a funeral home when the occasion arises that a family or friend has died. Mourners may have an emotional desire to light a candle in remembrance. The APP Gabriel permits a mourner to light a 5-day votive candle in remembrance through an installation of Vendalite's electronic candle system.

In an environment such as a Funeral Home, this is an important expression of an individual's belief.

In anticipation of the increased demand for such a spiritual need, a request has been made to further analyze the feasibility of introducing such a product for Funeral Homes.

Vendalite:

Vendalite, a manufacturer and distributor of electronic candles for 40 years entered into an agreement with a college to re-design and develop an electronic candle system utilizing LED's. This technology replaces a 25-year-old design that used less efficient incandescent bulbs. Administrators, the Fire Marshall and Insurance agents sleep easier with this product in, as compared to wax candles.

LEDs use less than 20% of the energy required by comparable incandescent lights and only a little more than half the energy required by compact fluorescent lights. Since LEDs last for 15 years, maintenance fees and replacement costs have been eliminated.

To further their green strategy, Vendalite has initiated a program to update outdated electronic candle systems through their conversion program of using old chassis and replacing old electronics with new LEDs. Such programs are self-financed through Vendalite's assistance using a revenue share program to pay for the project through revenues generated by the use of the upgraded system on a 50%/50% split until the invoice is paid. After that, the upgraded system is owned by the facility. A standard system has up to 70 candles. It can be said that the use of 50 large wax votives candles per week per year, produces carbon emissions equivalent to driving from Boston to Seattle.

The large 5-day glass globes (in colors of red, white and blue) on the systems are recycled wax glass globes. Candle holders are either traditional or oak leaf in design. A cash deposit must be made to activate the system. A credit card facilitator is also available as an option.

A new and innovative service is the introduction of Gabriel, an APP to light a 5-day votive candle at a location that has a Vendalite system, from anywhere in the world. This means that a mourner may light a candle for someone in a remembrance at a Funeral Home that has an

electronic candle system, as an intention of remembrance.
